## Fixture Secretary Report - Nov 2019

The key points to note are as follows:

- The new league season, now that we have been through the first couple of years of the restructure to 10 teams per division will continue to commence the first week of May and finish no later than the first week of September for all divisions.
- For the last two years we have not arranged a pre-season friendly but instead had a club match, which has worked pretty well. However I have agreed in principle that we will have a pre-season friendly with South Nutfield who I think won the Surrey Downs league last year and are keen to link up with us in this way. We have agreed a match at Blackheath on Sat 25<sup>th</sup>. Unless there any objections i will look to confirm this for a 1pm start.
- The Sunday fixtures are now all sorted and there have been two teams removed from the fixture list. We have dumped Old Dorkinians and unfortunately Londonshire CC can no longer get a team together so this match has been shelved
- There have been some changes of dates for some of the matches, namely Sunbury Squires who have been brought forward by a week and the Blues which have been moved from May to the end of August.
- Sunbury Squires were moved to enable a match with the England Deaf Team to be arranged for Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> August.
- There are currently 3 Sundays where there are no fixtures either home or away, namely 3<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> May and 12<sup>th</sup> July. The 3<sup>rd</sup> May is the first round of the VKO so this will be left blank at least until I know if we have been drawn home or away. If away we could try and get a home friendly fixture. The 24<sup>th</sup> May is not a VKO fixture so i will look to arrange a fixture for this date and likewise for the 12<sup>th</sup> July. These dates could be used for women's matches or perhaps a mixed club match or a club match which is used to get the older colts involved with the adults as discussed at our meeting at the Grantley.
- There are also a number of Sunday's where we have away matches thus leaving the Heath available. These are 21<sup>st</sup> June, 5<sup>th</sup> July, 26<sup>th</sup> July, 6<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> September. Three of these matches (5<sup>th</sup> July Bramley, 26<sup>th</sup> July Brook Strollers and 6<sup>th</sup> Sep Grayswood) alternate each year home and away, whereas Abinger 21<sup>st</sup> June and Ripley 13<sup>th</sup> Sep are always away. No doubt some thought will be given as to what we do, if anything, with the ground on these dates as well as the days where we have no match as detailed earlier
- Sunday home fixtures will start on 26<sup>th</sup> April and finish (if nothing else is arranged) on 30th August.
- Cricket Week will be held week commencing Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> August and all of the usual fixtures have been agreed with Old Cranleighans being the Friday opponents on a non MCC year.

• As soon as i have the l'Anson league and Cup fixtures (probably January) and the VKO fixtures (normally February) I will inform the committee.
